

Horse park rental disclaimers/additional notes:

- Everyone (riders and spectators) must complete a liability waiver prior to entering the park. This is required by our insurance company.
- Participants under the age of 18 are required to be accompanied by a legal parent or guardian. This parent/guardian will be required to complete a liability waiver on behalf of that participant.
- All participants under the age of 18 are required to wear a helmet while riding at all times in the park. Standard and additional safety equipment for yourself and your horse is recommended.
- All horses entering the property are required to provide vaccination records & date of last deworming. (Please inquire).
- All rings, equipment & obstacles are to be used at your own risk. It is up to you to determine the limits of yourself and your horse.
- All coaches/trainers are required to provide proof of insurance prior to entering the park.
- Zero tolerance policy for animal abuse.
- Use only the marked entrances and exits throughout the park (no "bushwhacking"). Remain on marked trails in order to prevent damage to homegrown hay & for your safety.
- Unfortunately no dogs are allowed in the horse park.
- All visitors must comply with all horse park rules/regulations. This is paramount to have the safest possible atmosphere for both participants & horses..

The following are some suggestions to make your visit to the park more comfortable:

- Bug spray (human and equine - highly recommend bug spray be brought by EVERYONE)
- Sunscreen
- Water bucket (a community bucket can be provided)
- Hay net (optional)
- Helmet, any additional safety equipment for yourself or your horse
- Additional training tools (personal equipment for you and your horse)
- Drink/snack
- Appropriate footwear for both riders & spectators (closed toe boots)
- Halter & lead rope (cooling out/hosing off)
- Cooler or sheet (for colder weather)
- Tack changes (optional)
- Folding chair(s) for spectating

WEATHER:

The park is of course outdoors, so we depend on the weather to guarantee certain terrain, but be assured, all of the park is groomed regularly and it is rare we have to close a portion due to flooding or another unforeseen cause. However those situations are of course possible. If there is a heavy rainfall during your time scheduled at the park we may have to limit what is available or you may opt to reschedule. If the weather is going to be a problem we will contact you to advise, or you can contact us with any of your weather concerns. If you have questionable weather on your end, you can contact us to confirm what's happening on our end before you depart from home.
